Create lessons quickly



Import **existing content** from Powerpoint, PDF, Google Slides, or Canva



Use ready-made Lumio **templates**



Find educator-created lessons in the **Lumio Library**

Broaden your search!

Lumio is used by educators around the world. To find the best resources in the Lumio Library, avoid using extremely narrow search filters. Check out the Instructional Toolkits category for research-based activity ideas.

Three types of pages



Individual Handout

Each student completes an individual copy of the lesson page.



Group Workspace

Divide students into groups (you choose the size). Each group collaborates on their own copy of the lesson page.



Whole-class Whiteboard

All students work together on the same page. Can turn off editing access as needed to refocus student attention.

Lumio lessons can accommodate over 300 individuals in a lesson at a time. However, Group Workspaces, Monster Quiz, and Team Quiz can only accommodate 54 participants at once, in nine teams of six.

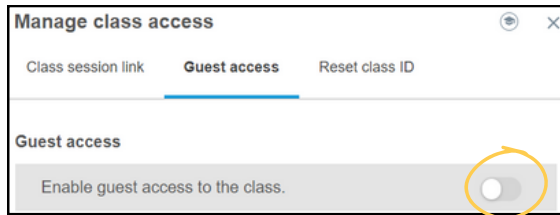

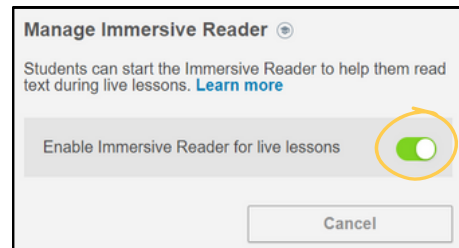

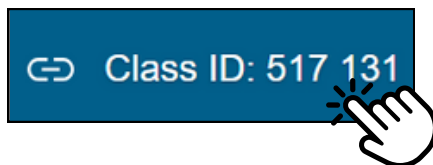
Turn off **guest access**. Students will login with school credentials and their work will be saved for later access.



Enable **Immersive Reader** to support reading needs and preferences.

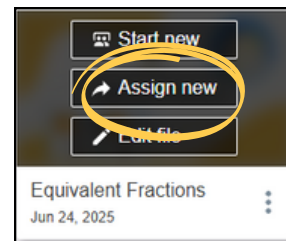
Multiple ways to share!
